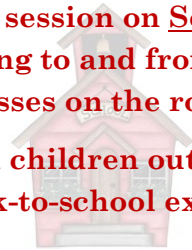
Come join us at the Hoyt Lakes Library on September 20th from 11am to 1pm for the Great North Star Read Together.
