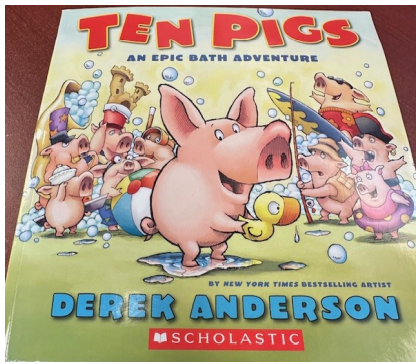

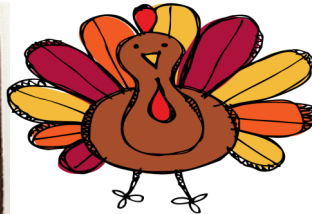

Songs of Mesabi is a pastiche of musical styles from the 19th through the 21st-century. Come along on this colorful journey with 18 original tunes paying homage to Greg Tiburzi's homeland--Minnesota's Iron Range.
